

## Creo PXT

The main purpose of the Creo PXT XTension for Quark is to enable you to make pre-press ready files easier and quicker than ever before. There have been many instances in which QuarkXPress postscript files simply did not work at all or had problems. On the other hand, files made using the Creo PXT XTension will work virtually every time. In addition to that, navigating through the Creo PXT XTension is much easier than using the Quark print menu.

You can easily receive the Creo PXT XTension for your version of QuarkXPress by contacting your sales representative. After you have successfully received the file, the installation process is fairly simple. To install the Creo PXT XTension on your version of QuarkXPress, simply follow these steps.

### Step 1:

Unstuff/unzip the "Creo PXT" file.

### Step 2:

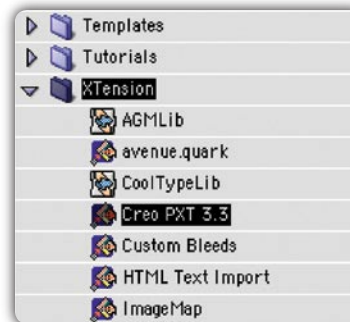
Move the unstuffed Creo PXT XTension into your XTension folder of your QuarkXPress installation directory. Usually this directory is located at "Macintosh HD > Applications > QuarkXPress > XTension."

### Step 3:

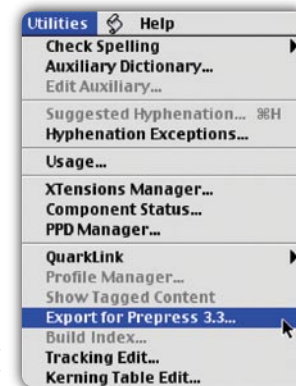
To use Creo PXT, open QuarkXPress with your publication. After you have successfully done the finishing touches on your publication, simply go to "Utilities" and select "Export for Prepress 3.3."

### Step 4:

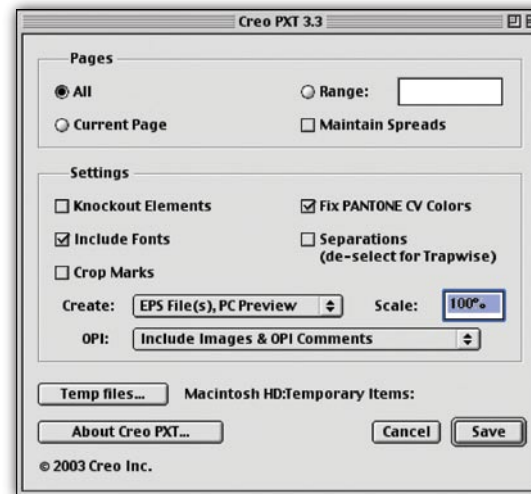
The last step is to make sure it matches the settings displayed on the next page at the bottom. Make especially sure that "Include Fonts" is checked. There are a couple of choices available in the "Create:" box, however we personally prefer these two choices: "EPS File(s), PC Preview" or "PostScript File."



Simply move the Creo PXT extension into your XTension folder of QuarkXPress.



To make pre-press ready files of your publication go to "Utilities" and choose "Export for Prepress 3.3."



Match your Creo PXT settings with the ones pictured above, and you're ready to go!
